ELIGIBILITY:

The show is open to all San Diego County artists. All work must be original and completed within the last three years. Work done under supervision of an instructor or work requiring special installation or handling will not be accepted.

ENTRY FEE:

First and second entry \$15.00.

Additional entries: \$10.00 each ~ no limit.

Checks made payable to Spanish Village Art Center (SVAC).

JUROR: Larry Baza

This year we are pleased to have as our juror, Larry Baza, a fine art consultant and arts administrator. He has worked in San Diego for 32 years as an arts professional. His work has included directorships of art organizations which have included Centro Cultural de la Raza; the County of San Diego's Public Arts Advisory Council; Sushi Performance & Visual Arts and Community Arts of San Diego. Currently, Larry and his partner Tom Noel are the owners of Noel-Baza Fine Art/India Street Gallery, San Diego, CA.

PREPARATION OF ART:

Absolute maximum size of 10 inches measured in any direction including frame & base. Two-dimensional work must be framed, excluding wrapped canvas, and be ready for hanging. Work must fit into a 10 inch cube.

Oils-Watercolors-Acrylics-Printmaking
Photography-Sculpture-Enamels
Fibers-Mixed-Ceramics-Glass-Wood
Jewelry-Digital-All Media. **No Molds**

CATALOG:

A catalog will list all works in the show and awards. Permission to photograph and reproduce entries is assumed granted unless reserved in writing.

SALES:

All exhibited work must be for sale. A 20% commission fee will be paid to Spanish Village Art Center. (purchase awards exempt). No work may be withdrawn from Gallery 21 before the close of the show.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

Artists whose work is accepted must be available to sit the gallery. A calendar/schedule will be kept for the exhibit duration. If unavailable for sitting, a \$25 sitter's fee may be required.
